

EMAIL COMMUNICATION

Email and Event Registration Request Form:

<https://purdue.force.com/community/s/eventrequest>

Submit a month before event date:

- At least two email communications will go out about your event
- A pre-event email will be sent to registrants

Submit less than a month before event date:

- One email communication will go out about your event
- A pre-event email will be sent to registrants

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

Essential Information to include in emails:

- Upcoming event dates and details
- Registration links (if available)
- Volunteer opportunities
- General club news
- Contact information

Additional items that could be added:

- Request for scholarship fund donations
- Invitation to log into Purdue Connect and update email preferences
- Invitation to purchase an alumni membership

MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS

Newsletter Template:

- Structured, regularly scheduled email that is sent to alumni in your area
- Highlights essential information discussed in previous slide
- Word document template is available to attach to email request

- Volunteer Opportunities
- Any other events happening that month

General Club News:

- Scholarship Information
- Election information
- Any other general news

- Make your emails actionable when possible
