- Applications: 78,526
- Admission rate: 49.8%
- Yield rate: 29.1%
- 40,735 undergraduates – West Lafayette
- 2,634 undergraduates – Indianapolis
- Total West Lafayette – 50,408 & Indianapolis – 2,834
- Average SAT: 1328/1600

# *Club Merchandise*

- **Alumni Club Merchandise**

  - Percentage of sales goes to Purdue for licensing fees

  - Clubs may use engagement funds to purchase items for door prizes or silent auctions

# ***Club Scholarships***

## **Clubs Scholarship Review**

- **Scholarship application will be removed from Scholarship Universe and replaced with a PFL scholarship application – email or printable**
- **Address, ZIP code, high school, and email will be fields on the application along with several essay questions**
- **Links to the scholarship application – club website and scholarship website**
- **Reminder –a scholarship donation option can be included on events with registration**
  - **Clubs with an endowment can specify funds to go to either the endowment or the support account**



# ***Club Scholarships - Timeline***

- **November 2024**
  - **Projections due to DFA – this is the amount clubs want to give out**
- **December 1<sup>st</sup> – application will go live**
- **January 2025**
  - **15<sup>th</sup> – deadline for clubs to have projected funds deposited into their scholarship account**
  - **25<sup>th</sup> – deadline for incoming freshmen to apply**
- **February 15<sup>th</sup> – deadline for scholarship committees to submit freshmen awardees to PFL**
- **March**
  - **1<sup>st</sup> – deadline for current Purdue students to apply**
  - **31<sup>st</sup> – deadline for scholarship committees to submit Purdue student awardees to PFL**

# ***Club Scholarships - Timeline***

- **March**
  - **Early to mid – DFA will begin releasing award packages. This will include club scholarships awarded**
- **April**
  - **4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday – Purdue Day of Giving – funds raised this day should be used for 2025-26 awarding**
- **May 1<sup>st</sup> – deadline for incoming freshmen to accept offer of admission**
- **June**
  - **Mid – DFA will begin releasing award packages to current Purdue students**

# ***ACH Process***

- **The process has begun!**
  - Denise will send the form to the club treasurer to complete
  - Please do not email the forms! Upload them where Quarterly Financial Reports are uploaded
    - <https://www.purdueforlife.org/alumni-leaders/clubs/alumni-club-quarterly-financial-report/>
    - If you have trouble uploading, you may send it through the mail (address below)
  - ACH forms will only be sent to clubs who have submitted the Club Agreement (signed by president and treasurer) and all board members have submitted the Statement of Integrity and Volunteer Policy
- **Allow 3-4 weeks after submission for the deposit to be received**
  - Deposits will still follow the check run dates, which are every two weeks
