Mackenzie Tweardy ('15) Women's Diving Biomedical Engineering Tweardy was a decorated diver for the Boilermakers - an All-American on the 10-meter platform and two-time team

Olympic Trials and was a member of the USA National Team. Tweardy worked in the R&D department at phsy1Q - a start up that is backed by Purdue - where she developed algorithms used on wearable devices for use in the clinical trial space. She now works as a Data Scientist at LifeBell Al, where she helps build wearable devices used in remote patient monitoring for the predication of deadly diseases.



Nkeiru (Ugwoaba) Abovwe ('11) Track & Field Exercise Physiology Abovwe competed in Track & Field at Purdue from 2008-2011 after the Seattle native began her career at Portland State. For the Boilermakers, she excelled in the

triple jump, long jump and 4x100 relay. She also graduated with an Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner degree from Columbia University. Currently, Abovwe serves as a boardcertified advanced practice provider on the cardiothoracic surgical team at Stanford Healthcare. Her area of clinical practice is in post-operative care of patients with Mechanical Circulatory Support devices & Heart Transplant patients.



Jacob Thieneman ('18) Football Mechanical Engineering Upon graduation from Purdue, Thieneman pursued playing at the next level as a Safety with the San Francisco 49ers.

During this pursuit, and through the

peak of the COVID-19 pandemic, he also utilized social media and public relations to work with a non-profit known as The Ventilator Project – an effort to produce low-cost ventilators for those in need. Currently, he is the co-founder and CEO of Digital Paradise, which helps companies leverage their stories online to gain attention, develop a community, generate leads, and ultimately create positive ROI.

PHASE 1 OVERVIEW

SOUTH END ZONE ADDITION

The long-awaited addition to Ross-Ade Stadium will connect the east and west sides of the facility in its 100th anniversary season, closing in the south end zone to create a complete bowl.

The south end zone and southeast sideline will serve as the new location for student seating. Ross-Ade Stadium will have the second highest percentage of student capacity in the Big Ten conference.

The completion of the bowl, in addition to the investment in the size of the concourse, will allow for a more accessible fan experience and include an additional elevator for ADA access as well as an additional restroom. The west wedge of the south end zone will also feature a new premium experience for fans to enjoy.

PLAYER ENTRANCE FROM KOZUCH FOOTBALL PERFORMANCE COMPLEX

The new stadium entry location will create a unique and iconic experience for Boilermaker Football student-athletes and fans that will be second to none.

Serving as the new stadium entry location for Purdue Football on game day, the new player entrance will aim to improve player safety as well as the game day atmosphere while also offering a new and exciting recruiting component

STUDENT-ATHLETE DINING FACILITY

The student-athlete dining facility will serve as a full production kitchen with an outdoor patio feature and a 150-person capacity.


With an architectural style complementary of the Kozuch Football Performance Complex, the facility will also include a demonstration kitchen to serve as a nutritional education space.

PRIORITY POINTS

Priority points are used to determine priority for seating assignments. During allocation, members will be ranked based upon total priority points and tickets are allocated in that order. Parking passes are allocated based first on giving level, then by priority points within that level. The categories in which you can earn points are:

LAMAR LUNDY LEAGUE

Lamar Lundy, a twosport athlete, and first African-American student to receive a football scholarship at Purdue University, was named MVP of

both the football and basketball

team his senior year. He led the football

team in receiving his senior season and was a two-time All-Big Ten (2nd Team). As a collegiate basketball player, Lamar scored 678 points (#73 all-time for the Boilermakers) and collected 533 rebounds (#29 all-time for the Boilermakers). Lundy was drafted by both the NFL and the NBA and chose football as his career post-college.

The Lundy League was created in 2023 by the John Purdue Club to recognize donors who support Purdue Athletics above and beyond their annual membership with a capital project gift of \$250,000 or more.







The John Purdue Club membership level required for access to purchase men's basketball premium seating is the All-American level - \$2,500 and above. In order to obtain Courtside seat access, an athletics capital project gift is also required.

A premium seat license deposit of \$1,000 per ticket is required upon agreement of new men's basketball premium seats which shall be a credit toward the license fee due for the final year of the agreement.






